

WEA Chinook believes strong school-home-community connection increases student success. To promote that connection, we offer Outreach Grants. All of the following criteria must be adhered to for consideration of a Grant.

WEA Community Outreach Grants are intended

- 1. To help members and local Education Associations strengthen connections with parents and communities in order to enhance support for schools,
- 2. To support a broad range of efforts to increase public awareness of the positive role schools and school employees play in local communities, and
- 3. To make WEA and the local Education Association a visible part of the education process.

In order for a project to be funded by a grant it must

- 1. Involve a significant number of parents and community members.
- 2. Establish a partnership among the Education Association, the school and the community.
- 3. Include a plan to visibly recognize WEA Chinook and the local Education Association as the funding source of the activity. Part of the plan must include approval by the building principal for the grant to be awarded by a WEA representative at a building staff meeting. (If you are buying books, use of a WEA bookplate is required and provided by us.)

A grant <u>cannot</u> supplant funding for programs that otherwise have been funded /or should be funded by the district (i.e., curriculum or classroom materials, supplies for an extracurricular event, etc.), or pay salaries, other than for qualified students who provide childcare during the activity (\$10 per hour per student maximum).

Send completed application via email to <u>kaxtell@washingtonea.org</u>. Grant requests must be submitted at least 30 days prior to the activity.

All grants expire July 31st; receipts must be received by that date for reimbursement. Monies may not be carried forward to the next school year.
